Welcome to Mass today!

If you are new to the area or this church, please make yourself known to one of the priests after Mass. There is tea and coffee available after the Solemn Mass in the Rectory, we hope you'll come through.

In the gospel reading today, we hear how happy are those who trust in the Lord.. We place all our trust in the resurrection of Christ. If our hope in him has been for this life only then we are the most unfortunate of all people. Christ is risen from the dead and this is the source of our happiness. In him we put our trust and ask him for nothing more!



Sunday School at the 11.00am Mass is for Children of Primary School age. Follow the cross during the Gloria and join the others for a Liturgy of the Word.

The Church is closed now, so there will be no Mass apart from 11am on Sundays. Daily Mass will be available at OL of La Salette, 12.35pm each day; and Sunday Mass here will be at 11am either in Church or across the road in *The Sidings*. Watch for updates.

Mass intentions requested during the closed period will be offered, but elsewhere.

Thank you to those who helped clear the Church yesterday, the dust starts in earnest tomorrow!

Next Sunday will be across the way in the *Sidings*. We will not be back in Church till Ash Wednesday. Thank you to Jack for his generous hospitality.

For legislators and law enforcement agencies; may they strengthen and protect the rights of workers.


A prayer for those facing exploitation

O God, Gracious God, from your abundance all gifts and skills are bestowed, making us participants in your work of creation. By the word of your Son, confront our greed, challenge us when we treat people as means of profit, or discriminate unjustly against our fellow human beings. Raise us up to new life in your service that in all our works begun, continued and ended in you we may glorify your holy name. Through Jesus Christ your Son, our Lord, Amen.

Racial Justice Sunday, today, focuses on the experiences of ethnic communities in England and Wales. It is a day on which we all called to earnestly pray for an end to racism and racial inequality in our country. The theme this year is Dignity of Work, looking at how all people must not be exploited or face discrimination and hatred in their work.

The theme "Dignity for all workers", recognising the problems faced by people due to racism and ethnic discrimination in the workplace.

In a world steeped in violence, conflict, and discrimination, the Gospel demands that we acknowledge the dignity of the human person, the necessity of building peace, prosperity, justice for all. In *Octogesima Ad-veniens* and *Gaudium et Spes*, St Paul VI teaches that "all people have a right to work ... to lead a worthy life on the material, social, cultural and spiritual level". We are therefore called to ensure people are not exploited while they work, and to open our hearts to those who face this hatred. "As you




