

## Litany of Loreto

Loreto is one of the holiest and most popular pilgrimage destinations in Italy. Tradition tells that this is the house where our Blessed Mother was conceived and born, grew up, and where the Archangel Gabriel asked her to become the Mother of God. This is also believed to be the house where the Holy Family lived; where Jesus grew up and worked until he left to reveal Himself to mankind. The Holy House was carried from the Holy Land by angels to save it from the imminent fall of Jerusalem to the Turks, in 1291. This litany was composed during the Middle Ages and holds a place of honour in the life of the Church due to its faithful use at the shrine of the Holy House at Loreto.




