The Seven Sorrows Rosary

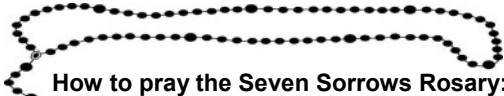
Most people know the Holy Rosary with the ten decades of 20 mysteries. Have you ever prayed the Seven Sorrows Rosary? It is so powerful!

The prayer dates back to the Middle Ages. Many graces result from praying this devotion, however, it should not replace the traditional rosary. Our Lady requests the faithful to pray the Seven Sorrows Rosary on Tuesdays and Fridays.



Our Lady makes promises when the 7 sorrows rosary is prayed.

1. The hardest hearts shall change, if you pray it for yourself or for others.
2. You shall be freed from obsessions and addiction.
3. It will win us true repentance of our sins and free our souls from guilt and remorse.
4. Clear understanding of the causes of your sin with ability to change.
5. You shall obtain whatever you ask, if praying this rosary from the heart.



How to pray the Seven Sorrows Rosary:

✠ In the name of the Father....

My God, I offer you this Rosary for your glory, so I can honour your Holy Mother, the Blessed Virgin, so I can share and meditate upon her suffering. I humbly beg you to give me true repentance for all my sins. Give me wisdom and humility, so that I may receive all the indulgences contained in this prayer.

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments, but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, who art all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

3x Hail Marys in honour of Our Lady's *Most Merciful Mother*, remind us always about the Sorrows of your Son, Jesus."

Mary Stands at the Foot of the Cross

1x Our Father and 7x Hail Marys.

6. The Sixth Sword of Sorrow:

Mary Receives the Dead Body of Jesus

1x Our Father and 7x Hail Marys.

7. The Seventh Sword of Sorrow:

The Body of Jesus is Placed in the Tomb

1x Our Father and 7x Hail Marys.

Queen of Martyrs, your heart suffered so much. I beg you, by the merits of the tears you shed in these terrible and sorrowful times, to obtain for me and all the sinners of the world the grace of complete sincerity and repentance. Amen.
