The Creed

**I believe in one God,

begotten, not made,
being of one substance with the Father;
by whom all things were made;
who for us men and for our salvation
came down from heaven,
(genuflect)
and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of
the Virgin Mary,
and was made man;
and was crucified also for us under Pon-
tius Pilate;
he suffered and was buried;
and the third day he rose again accord-
ing to the Scriptures,**

and ascended into heaven,
and sitteth on the right hand of the Fa-
ther;

and he shall come again, with glory,
to judge both the quick and the dead;
whose kingdom shall have no end.
And I believe in the Holy Ghost the Lord,
